As a participant of Little Rescue on the Prairie Barn Cat adoption program, I understand and agree to the following (please initial each line):

- The cats have been spayed or neutered, vaccinated for rabies and FVRCP and ear tipped.
- I agree to pay a \$ _____ donation per cat to help Little Rescue on the Prairie with supplies and gasoline (we may waive the fee depending on the number of cats you adopt). All donations are tax deductible. You can find our PayPal donation button at Littlerescue.org.
- Little Rescue on the Prairie cannot guarantee cat temperament. Feral cats may turn out to be friendly and semi feral cats may turn out to be unfriendly.
- I am over 21 years of age.
- I will not let any child under the age of 13 provide daily care to the cat(s) I adopt.
- I have knowledge and consent of all adults in the household.
- I have the property owner or landlord's consent to bring the cats(s) to live on the property.
- I agree to a site inspection (to assure a secure area and safe transition for the cats).
- I will provide the cat(s) a dry, safe shelter with adequate warmth during the winter months.
- I will provide an adequate amount of nutritious cat food and clean water on a daily basis.
- I will monitor the health and safety of the cat(s) and vaccinate the cat(s) if needed. I understand that LROP can loan me traps to take the cats to the vet.
- I am financially able and willing to pay for veterinary expenses in emergency situations.
- If a cat strays prior to being thoroughly acclimatized or has difficulty finding its way back to my barn/enclosure, I will continue to set out food and water to encourage the cat to stay close. I will also sprinkle that particular cat's used litter (specifically feces) around the property to help lure the cat back to its territory. I understand cats often hide for a period of time but usually stay on or near premises.
- I understand that barn cats sometimes will not stay at their rehoming location.
- I agree to keep feeding cat(s) for several weeks, even if I do not see the cat(s), to determine whether they have actually left the area.
- If I have to move and cannot take the cat(s) with me or become unable to care for the cat(s) in any way, I will contact Little Rescue on the Prairie.
- I will not give away, sell, relocate, or otherwise forfeit the care of the cat(s) without consulting with Little Rescue on the Prairie.
- If I break any of the provisions of this agreement, Little Rescue on the Prairie is permitted to enter my property to retake possession of the cat(s).
- I will be financially responsible for any borrowed equipment not returned to Little Rescue on the Prairie within 30 days of adoption.



Personal or Property Damage and/or Injury

I agree that accidental animal bites or other injuries to humans and other animals do occur, and I agree to hold harmless and indemnify, and protect Little Rescue on the Prairie from any claim or suit filed by someone as a result of such incident.

In addition, Little and Rescue on the Prairie will not be responsible if an animal should damage or destroy property belonging to caregiver, caregiver household, or others, or if the animal shall transfer any disease, internal or external parasites to other animals and people in caregiver's household.

I understand that if I am approved for receive a barn cat, this declaration represents a legal contract between me as the home caregiver and Little Rescue on the Prairie.

I understand that if I am approved to receive a barn cat, I must abide by this agreement and that this agreement applies to any and all animals that I receive from Little Rescue on the Prairie through the Barn Cat Program.

I agree to hold Little Rescue on the Prairie, or it's representatives, harmless and without liability for any harm to my person or property or others by the cat I have adopted.

I acknowledge that the information provided on this application is correct to the best of my knowledge. If at any time the information I have provided changes, I will provide the updated information to Little Rescue on the Prairie Barn Cat program.
